

Manual Skills Assessment

The Manual Skills Assessment evaluates the applicant's ability to competently and smoothly perform tying and suturing

The following skills must be evaluated, by a surgeon.

ALL skills must be demonstrated, not just one or two.

The surgeon will initial each box that represents the skill level achieved.

The initialing of the boxes must be done by the surgeon, not the applicant.

NO check marks will be accepted (X or ✓)

Applicant will be allowed a maximum of two (2) attempts at each skill.
